As you are aware of the Maharashtra Government's decision to reopen the colleges for limited hours for classes 11th and 12th from 04th October, 2021, we solicit your consent after reading the following requisite precautions in compliance with the Covid-19 regulations.

As we gear up to resume the regular offline classes for the 11th & 12th standard students of our College, I wish to notify you about our proposed safety measures:-

- Entry timings to campus will be staggered for the students to prevent crowding. At a given time, there will be 30-40 students only in a class. For the remaining students, online lectures will continue as per the regular time table.
- The college premises including the furniture will be sanitized everyday with WHO recommended anti-virus solution.
- Every person on Campus must maintain social distancing and wear a mask compulsorily.
- Temperature will be checked at the entrance by the College Security everyday.
- Sanitizers will be placed at the entrance and on foyers for the students.
- Students will have to carry their own personal sanitizer too.
- Each Classroom will have separated seating arrangement as per the stipulated norms.
- Duration of the students' stay in College will be approximately 2.30 to 3.00 hours each day without any 'Recess'.
- Eating will be strictly prohibited on Campus .All will carry drinking water in their own water bottles.
- All students will have to be self sufficient. Sharing of stationery, books or any belongings will not be permitted.
- Parents and other visitors will not be allowed to enter the Campus.
- If any student or a family member is unwell, he/she should not attend college on those days. While resuming after a period of illness, medical fitness certificate should be submitted in order to attend lectures.
- An undertaking will have to be signed by the parents who are willing to send their wards for offline classes without which the students will not be allowed to enter the premises.

All the above processes will be strictly implemented and our classes on Campus will begin, subject to sufficient number of consents received from the parents of our students. The final decision and schedule will be intimated to you on the basis of the percentage of consents from parents.
