

C. Evaluation: Changes after implementation of Autonomy

Reforms were introduced for a continuous formative assessment and a step towards more rigorous learning-evaluation regime to ensure continuous learning and also effectively gauge performance of learners. The Scheme of Evaluation of 60:40 pattern has been implemented as indicated below:

- Continuous Evaluation (CE) 40 Marks
 - -With two components CE1 and CE2
 - -Attendance Compulsory in each component
 - -Requirement for Passing Overall 40%
- Semester End Examination (SE) 60 Marks
 - -Requirement for Passing Overall 40%

D. Other Quality Initiatives:

Mentoring

The College has made an attempt to initiate the mentoring of learners by teachers. Two types of mentoring sessions were planned as follows:

- -By Faculty Members: Every class had a full-time mentor and there were dedicated sessions allotted in time-table for mentoring. These sessions were conducted online.
- -By Alumni: A few alumni members had agreed to be mentoring learners. Online set up was put in place via WhatsApp and mails.

This initiative, though appreciated by the learners, had a lukewarm response from the learners.
