- Use Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
- Follow APA style for references. Footnotes must include the author's name, title of the work, place, and year of publication.
- Maps, diagrams, and photographs (if any) should be submitted in JPEG format of high resolution.
- Plagiarism limit: 10%
- Priority will be given to papers that align closely with the conference theme and sub-themes.
