New debentures would be sold at 14% interest and will be sold at par. Preference shares will carry 15% rate of interest and will be sold at par. Equity shares currently selling at Rs. 100 would be sold at Rs. 95. The shareholders required rate of return is to be 17 percent consisting of a dividend yield of 10 percent and an expected growth rate of 7 percent. Estimated retained earnings for the year are Rs. 50,000. The corporate tax is 35 percent.

- The amount of additional equity capital to be raised by issuing new shares.
- Calculate the cost of new equity shares and retained earnings.
- Calculate the weighted average cost of capital for intended expansion.
